TASTING NOTES AND PAIRINGS

This ruby-coloured wine with cherry highlights reveals a complex nose of redcurrant, mingled with notes of tobacco and coffee. Tannic on the palate, this wine offers good length, with moderately woody notes. It will go wonderfully with pheasant with figs, grilled rib steak with herbs or a risotto with porcini mushrooms and Parmesan cheese. Serve between 14 and 16°C.

OUR VINEYARD

Located in the upper part of Clos de Vougeot, the Petit Maupertui vineyard, situated directly below Grands Echézeaux, is undoubtedly one of the most highly rated parts of this grand cru. It has a gentle slope facing east. Covering an area of 0.56 hectares, this 85-year-old vineyard is a selection of Pinot Noir producing small bunches. The clay-limestone soil is quite stony, with a limestone subsoil.

VINIFICATION AND AGEING

Hand-picked grapes. Rigorous sorting of grapes upon arrival at the winery. Partial or total destemming depending on the vintage. Vatting in stainless steel vats. Alcoholic fermentation with alternating pumping over and punching down. Devatting then pressing of the marc. Aged for around 18 months in French oak barrels before bottling.
