## Ladoix *Les Combottes*

**Varietal: Pinot Noir / Appellation: Ladoix / Rouge**  
**Level: Village / Average production: 5 900 bottles**

### TASTING NOTES AND PAIRINGS

With its ruby red colour and purple highlights, this wine reveals a fresh nose of red fruits and eucalyptus. Powerful, it offers a frank attack on the palate and a beautiful persistence. Slightly woody, it can accompany a veal chop with mushroom sauce, a vegetable and poultry stir-fry, aubergine caviar or lasagne with grilled vegetables.

### OUR VINEYARD

Located at the foot of the hill of Corton, these vineyards are situated at an altitude of 250 meters, with south-west exposure. The average age of the vines is 55 years. The soil is clay-limestone on chailles (limestone pebbles). These chailles ensure that these relatively fertile soils have good drainage, which is favourable for early ripening and maturation of the grapes.

### VINIFICATION AND AGEING

Hand-picked grapes. Rigorous sorting of grapes upon arrival at the winery. 100% destemming. Vatting in stainless steel vats. Alcoholic fermentation with alternating pumping over and punching down. Devatting followed by pressing of the marc. Aged in French oak barrels for at least 10 months before bottling.
