TASTING NOTES AND PAIRINGS

With its garnet red color and ruby highlights, this wine offers a frank and elegant nose with notes of strawberry. The delicate palate offers a beautiful freshness. Medium oaky, it will be the perfect companion to a creamy tournedos, a strong cheese, such as Morbier, or a pumpkin gratin. Serve between 14 and 16°C.

OUR VINEYARD

Facing south, this 0.25 ha plot of Pinot Noir is a vine that is more than a hundred years old, having been planted in 1913! Its soil is clay-limestone, quite deep at the bottom of the hill of Corton.

VINIFICATION AND AGEING

Hand-harvested. The grapes are rigorously sorted upon arrival at the winery. 100% destemmed.
