TASTING NOTES AND PAIRINGS

Boasting a beautiful, bright straw-yellow color, this wine reveals aromas of citrus and white-fleshed fruit on the nose.

OUR VINEYARD

This vineyard planted with Chardonnay, with a surface area of 0.20 ha, is more than a hundred years old: it was planted in 1913. Its clay-limestone soil is quite deep at the bottom of the hill of Corton. It faces south.

VINIFICATION AND AGEING

Hand-harvested. Pressing and settling. Alcoholic fermentation in French oak barrels. Aging on fine lees. Malolactic fermentation. Aging for at least 8 months before bottling.
